**Employees must attend the classroom portion in order to qualify for certification.**

**For employees attending the class, if they pass the classroom portion, the trainer will set up a time to visit their site and observe your operation of the aerial lift. The lift must be in good operating condition and must be available for use.**

- Aerial lifts include scissor lifts, man lifts, boom lifts (truck mounted and/or trailer mounted), platform lifts, or other type of man lift system.
- Each employee must provide their own safety harness if operating any type of boom lift.
- These are NOT forklifts – but are specifically designed to handle humans working at elevated levels.
- **This is not a basic training class – remember you must be a qualified operator – this is a certification class. If you have never operated a lift before, you may still attend the class, however there WILL be limitations on the certification process.**
- The certification is good for 3 years and satisfies OSHA requirements.

**You must RSVP, provide an email address for the employee attending, and provide the name and phone number of the site Supervisor, and the type of lift(s) to be operated (Type & model #).**
